Understanding The Risk Factors for Mental Illness

One of the ongoing problems with diagnosis and treatment of mental illness in seniors is the fact that older adults are more likely to report physical symptoms than psychiatric complaints. However, even the normal emotional and physical stresses that go along with aging can be risk factors for mental illnesses, like anxiety and depression.

The Geriatric Mental Health Foundation lists a number of potential triggers for mental illness in seniors:

Alcohol or substance abuse

Change of environment, like moving into assisted living

Dementia-causing illness (e.g. Alzheimer's disease)

Illness or loss of a loved one

Long-term illness (e.g., cancer or heart disease)

Medication interactions

Physical disability

Physical illnesses that can affect emotion, memory and thought

Poor diet or malnutrition

If you notice a change in your mental state, Please contact your Personal Care Physician and or the Lake County Health Department. Their staff provides treatment, training and support services to persons experiencing problems related to emotional and mental illness, or drug and alcohol addiction. Park Place offers a variety of Enhancement Groups to help you connect with people facing similar challenges and who are likely to have a common purpose to understand one another. The Park Place Memory Café meets every second Wednesday 1:30 pm - 3:00 pm. Share your stories and socialize with others who have concerns about their memory or the memory of a loved one. 

Information you should know



Senior Citizens Assessment Freeze Homestead Exemption Outreach Sessions April 18th, 10am - 2pm at Park Place.

The Chief County Assessment Office and the Lake County Township Assessors Association will hold several public outreach sessions to assist residents in completing the 2019 Senior Citizen Assessment Freeze Application for taxes payable in 2020; as well as service taxpayer needs on other homestead exemptions offered. Residents will work one on one with a staff member to complete the necessary exemption forms. Qualifications are 65 years old or older during the tax year, own the property as your principal residence for the last two Jan. 1st(2018 and 2019), 2018 total household income is \$55,000 or less. Be prepared to bring copies of income received such as: 2018 Federal Income Tax Form , Social Security Statement (SSA-1099), If the property is owned in Trust, you may need to provide proof of the beneficiary.

Helpful Tax Tips for Seniors

The standard deduction has been doubled. Good news for lots of people. Bad news for larger families with children. Personal exemptions have gone away. Many filers who have itemized personal deductions over the years, won't need to. You will find that the 1040 return is much shorter.

Forgetting to take your required minimum distributions from your retirement account can cost you big time. "Some people forget," says Douglas Birch, managing director of the tax group at CBIZ in Clearwater, Florida. "If you miss the withdrawal, you will be subject not only to the taxes, but a 50 percent excise penalty on the amount you were supposed to take out, but didn't."

Some people don't want to take their retirement account distributions or don't need to. A 401(k) or IRA withdrawal causes your income to go up for that year, and that may impact your Social Security taxes and increase your Medicare payments. If the RMD instead goes directly to a charity, it stays off your tax return and reduces your income.

Planned Giving

You may chose to include Waukegan Township Park Place in your estate plan, so you can continue to help other seniors even after they you're gone. By making a "gift ", you too can continue to bring needed services and programming to other seniors of Waukegan Township even after your lifetime. How it works: Sign the appropriate paperwork making Waukegan Township Park Place a beneficiary of your will, trust, insurance or retirement assets.
