“NEW” Waukegan Township Transit Card

Waukegan Township has always led the way in providing flexible transportation by using the Waukegan Township shuttle service and our printed taxi-ticket. We are delighted to announce that we are upgrading our Taxi Ticket Program! Beginning on January 1, 2022, our benefits will be provided through a debit card system, the Waukegan Township Transit Card. The Waukegan Township Transit Card upgrades your benefit in these ways:

- Timely access to funds: \$18 will be deposited automatically on the first of each month.
- Freedom of choice in transportation options: Use your WT Transit card for taxi, Uber, Lyft, Metra, Lake County Eldercare medical transportation, or Ventra for Pace or Dial-a-ride!
- Ease of use: After a one-time activation call, simply swipe your card to pay for rides!
- Check your balance: You can track your balance on your smartphone or other Internet device.

Please note that your transit dollars will not accrue. You cannot accumulate more than \$18 in monthly transit funds. Lost or stolen cards may be replaced for a \$5.00 fee.

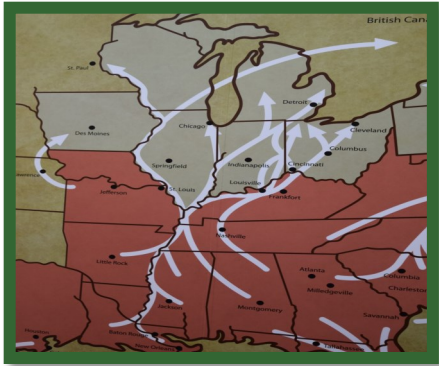

Kemper Center Tour and Holiday Fun, Tuesday, November 30, 2021

Celebrate history and the holidays at Kenosha's historic Kemper Center! We will start with an exclusive tour of the lavishly decorated buildings, including the Gallery of Trees, Durkee Mansion, Cloister and Chapel. Next you will feast at the Hob Knob, a traditional Wisconsin Supper Club, before enjoying a tour of beautifully decorated homes and a stop downtown for a sweet treat. Fee of \$97 includes all transportation, tours, dinner, and dessert. Departs Park Place at 1:00 p.m. and returns after 8:00 p.m.



Underground Railroad Tour of Bronzeville, Tuesday, February 15, 2022

Explore the history of the Underground Railroad in Chicago! The Bronzeville Historical Society presents this tour that includes narration of architectural highlights of buildings, churches and gravesites. Hear narratives of the efforts of abolitionists, union soldiers, and citizens from Chicago. Highlights include quilts, photographs, maps and biographies at selected sites. Trained tour guides will profile heroic freedom seekers. Afterwards, we will enjoy lunch at Chicago's Home of Chicken and Waffles. Adler Planetarium, Tuesday, March 1, 2022

New Countywide Paratransit System Expected in 2022

A new borderless countywide paratransit service is getting closer to launching in Lake County! At the Sept. 14th meeting, the Lake County Board approved a resolution to work with Pace Suburban Bus Co. on a new paratransit service known as **Ride Lake County**. Currently, several communities, townships and transit agencies offer paratransit options in Lake County, but all these services have different geographic boundaries, hours of service, rates, and more.

The proposed **Ride Lake County** service aims to provide one consistent service that individuals aged 60+ and those with disabilities, can use to get to work, grocery stores, medical appointments and more throughout Lake County. Existing paratransit services will remain in place until the new service is launched, which is expected in 2022.

Class Details

Total Body Blast

Total Body Blast is a quick-paced resistance training class. Participants should have a chair and 1 of the following: weights, a water bottle, two cans or a resistance band.

Serenity Stretch

Serenity Stretch is a stretch class for loosening tight muscles and improving range of motion. A yoga strap, a long belt, or a long towel would be helpful for increasing flexibility.

Chair Workout Warrior

Chair Workout Warrior focuses on upper body strength. It is great for participants needing to sit or hold on to a chair to exercise. Even with in a it will be challenging! Participants should have weights, a resistance band, and should bring their own water.

Functional Fitness

Functional Fitness focuses on lower body strength, It helps with everyday movements such as bending down, squatting, reaching and lifting. Legs and shoulders are the primary focus of training. Participants should have weights, a resistance band, and should bring their own water.

YOGA Demonstrations December 14th through December 23rd (Tuesdays and Thursdays 11:15 am to 12:15pm)

Dec 14 Session 1: Pranayama and Asana, Level of Fitness: All /Pranayama is third of the eight "limbs" of yoga. It focuses on regulating the inhalation, exhalation and pauses between breaths, which is the foundation of the practice. Asana is the fourth limb of yoga, which is known as the postures that are performed in a yoga practice. Common asanas for **Sun Salutation A** will be covered in this session.

Dec 16 Session 2: Hatha Level of Fitness: All (can be done seated in a chair, on the floor, or standing). Please bring your own mat and kneeling pad if practicing on the floor. Hatha is a style of yoga that includes pranayama into asana, and learning how to transition from one pose to the next with breath. **Sun Salutation A** will be taught in this session.

Dec 21 Session 3: Vinyasa, Level of Fitness: All (can be done seated in a chair, on the floor, or standing). Please bring your own mat and kneeling pad if practicing on the floor. Vinyasa is a style of yoga that incorporates Hatha; it requires performing the poses in a sequence for aerobic and strength training

Dec 23 Session 4: Iyengar, Yin and Restorative, Level of Fitness: Intermediate to Advanced. Participants should be able to stand, have good balance, and transition between sitting and standing with ease. Participants should also bring their own equipment, especially for floor practice. A strap can be a long cloth belt, old house robe sash, etc. Yoga blocks help to extend arm reach while working on balance, and can support the head like a pillow. Iyengar and Yin are styles of yoga that uses props such as yoga blocks and straps to deepen and hold poses longer. They improves circulation, flexibility, range of motion and relieves tight muscles. Restorative yoga focuses on 4 to 5 resting poses using props to encourage relaxation and stress relief. Please bring a blanket, yoga blocks and/or a pillow.

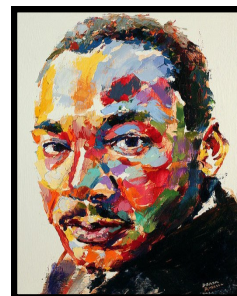
