The Patricia A. Jones Center was just awarded a 2022-2023 grant from the that will assist those 55+. To receive this service you must reside within Waukegan Township and travel for social gatherings, via Uber or Lyft. This service will be offered Saturdays and Sundays. If you are interested in this program please contact the Patricia A. Jones Center on the transportation hotline at 847-599-2936.

- 1) Register by calling the Patricia A. Jones Center hotline at 847-599-2936. A form will be mailed to you along with a user guide to assist in using the ridesharing service. When registering please provide a copy of a current ID. If you are a member of the Waukegan Township transit card program an ID will not be required.
- 2) Once registered, users will call the Transportation Coordinator by the Thursday prior to requesting weekend service. Users may request rides to and from any location within a 10-mile radius of their home address.
- 3) The Patricia A. Jones Center will arrange weekend services using Lyft for Business or Uber for Business.
- 4) The rideshare service will contact you to confirm transportation locations and times for each individual.
- 5) The Patricia A. Jones Center will call each the following week between Monday and Wednesday to ensure that all transportation was precise and on time.

Total Body Blast

Total Body Blast is a quick-paced resistance training class. Participants should have a chair and 1 of the following: weights, a water bottle, two cans or a resistance band.

Serenity Stretch

Serenity Stretch is a stretch class for loosening tight muscles and improving range of motion. A yoga strap, a long belt, or a long towel would be helpful for increasing flexibility.

Functional Fitness
