# Waukegan Township Day Trips

## The National Museum of Puerto Rican Art and Culture, and Paseo Boricua, The Puerto Rican Promenade - September 20, 2022

Immerse yourself in the colorful culture and history of the Puerto Rican community with this tour of the Humboldt Park area including the National Museum of Puerto Rican Art and Culture. This tour will provide a fresh, inspiring experience one of the most unique cultural and commercial districts in Chicago. Our tour will be led by Eduardo Arocho, who has over 26 years of experience leading tours in the Puerto Rican community. He is a historian, poet, arts/community activist, entrepreneur, and tour guide with first-hand knowledge of Humboldt Park. Tour includes lunch at an authentic, family-owned Puerto Rican restaurant. We will depart Patricia A. Jones Center at 9:00a.m. The fee of \$70 cover all tours, lunch and transportation.



## Criminals, Gangsters & Mobsters Tour of Chicago - October 18, 2022

Escape into Chicago's underworld on a crime and mob tour with stops on and off the luxury, climate-controlled bus. True crime and history buffs will enjoy the live commentary and walking tour paths to explore historic crime scenes with great photo opportunities. Learn the true history of infamous characters like Gangster Al Capone, The Untouchables, The Chicago Mob, Prohibition, John Dillinger, Frank "The Enforcer" Nitti, Cap George Streeter, Leopold & Loeb, H.H. Holmes & more. We will visit historic landmark buildings including Biograph Theater, Holy Name Cathedral, Cook County Criminal Courthouse, Harry Caray's Italian Steakhouse, etc. We will also tour famous Chicago neighborhoods: Streeterville, River North, Gold Coast, Lincoln Park, Old Town, Loop, and Magnificent Mile. ## Illinois Holocaust Museum and Ghost Army Exhibit - November 10, 2022



Take history to heart at the Illinois Holocaust Museum and Education Center. We will visit the museum to explore events leading to the Holocaust, hear survival stories, and find hope moving forward. The exhibit, Ghost Army: The Combat Con Artists of World War II tells the heroic tale of the top-secret U.S. Army's 23rd Headquarters Special Troops, known as the "Ghost Army," and their covert operations across Europe that helped win the war, armed with nothing heavier than .50 caliber machine guns. This carefully selected group of artists, engineers, professional soldiers, and draftees (the first mobile, multimedia, tactical deception unit in U.S. Army history) which saved thousands of lives and

played an important part in allied victory in World War II. After our visit, we will enjoy family-style lunch at Maggiano's Little Italy. The \$97 fee includes museum and exhibits, lunch, and round-trip transportation. This trip departs at 9:00 am. and will return after 3:00 pm.

This can include, but is not limited to doctors visits, religious functions, grocery shopping or visiting relatives. Transportation will be provided via Uber or Lyft. This service will be offered Saturdays and Sundays only. If you are interested in this program please contact the Patricia A. Jones Center at 847-599-2936.



- 1) Register by calling the Patricia A. Jones Center hotline at **847-599-2936**. A form will be mailed to you along with a user guide to assist in using the ridesharing service. When registering please provide a valid copy of a current ID. If you are a member of the Waukegan Township transit card program, an ID will not be required.
- 2) Once registered, users will call the Transportation Coordinator on or before the weekend services are needed.
- 3) Users may request rides to and from any location within a 10-mile radius of their home address.
- 4) The Patricia A. Jones Center will arrange weekend services using Lyft for Business or Uber for Business.
- 5) The rideshare service will contact you to confirm transportation locations and times for each individual.
- 6) The Patricia A. Jones Center will contact each rider the following week to ensure that transportation was precise and on time.

## Class Details

### Total Body Blast

Total Body Blast is a quick-paced resistance training class. Participants should have a chair and 1 of the following: weights, a water bottle, two cans or a resistance band.

### Serenity Stretch

Serenity Stretch is a stretch class for loosening tight muscles and improving range of motion. A yoga strap, a long belt, or a long towel would be helpful for increasing flexibility.

### Chair Workout Warrior

Chair Workout Warrior focuses on upper body strength. It is great for participants needing to sit or hold on to a chair to exercise. Even with in a it will be challenging! Participants should have weights, a resistance band, and should bring their own water.

### Functional Fitness

Functional Fitness focuses on lower body strength, It helps with everyday movements such as bending down, squatting, reaching and lifting. Legs and shoulders are the primary focus of training. Participants should have weights, a resistance band, and should bring their own water.

### Cardio Circuit Training

Cardio Circuit Training is a quick paced aerobic and resistance training class. Circuits consist of 3-6 exercises performed vertical style. At lease 3 circuits will be done each class. Participants should have weights, a resistance band, and should bring their own water.

## A Matter of Balance

Matter of Balance is an on-site eight week evidence based program which helps older adults reduce their fear of falling by learning to view falls as controllable. This program is specifically designed to reduce the fear of falling and improve activity levels among older adults. The program includes eight two-hour classes presented to a small group of participants led by trained coaches. The program enables participants to set goals for increasing activity levels, making small changes to reduce fall risks at home, and exercise to increase strength and balance.
