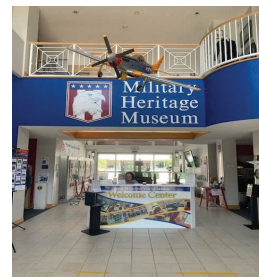

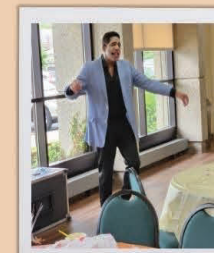

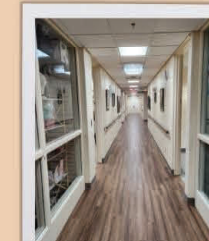

TJQMBB	<i>To improve strength, balance, and mobility, and to prevent falls in older adults.</i>
Total Body Conditioning	<i>Total Body Conditioning is a resistance training class. Equipment required: Chair, weights or two water bottles, two cans and/or a resistance band.</i>
Serenity Stretch	<i>Serenity Stretch is a stretch class for loosening tight muscles. A yoga strap, a long belt or a long towel would be helpful, especially if you're tight or have limited range of motion.</i>
Chair Workout Warrior	<i>Chair Workouts are great for those needing to sit for some of the exercises, or hold on to a chair to exercise.</i>
Functional Fitness	<i>Functional Fitness is a class that covers exercise that helps with everyday movement such as bending down, squatting, reaching and lifting. Legs and shoulders are the primary focus of training.</i>

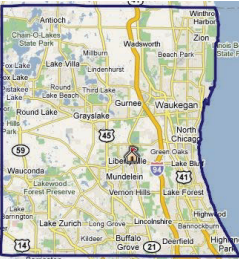

Ride Lake County

Ride Lake County is a new borderless countywide paratransit service, meaning **seniors ages 60+ and people with disabilities** can get transportation to anywhere in Lake County for work, shopping, medical appointments, and more. Riders will call the PACE Call Center to schedule trips in advance. All Ride Lake County vehicles are **wheelchair accessible** and provide **curb-to-curb service** from your decided pick up and drop-off locations. **This bus service will run from 6:00am to 6:00pm, seven days a week, excluding holidays.** One-way fares will vary between \$2.00 and \$6.00 depending on the distance. Rides can be scheduled up to 7 days in advance. Ride Lake County is sponsored by **Lake County and PACE Suburban Bus Co.** Call 1-800-201-6446 to register today.

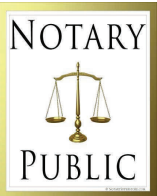
