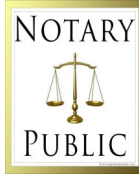

Class Details

Circuit Training	This is a supervised training class that involves timed rotations around each piece of exercise equipment. This class will occur in the fitness center, with a limit of 10 persons per class. You must sign up prior to participating. Sign up sheets will be posted on the fitness center door.
Total Body Blast	Total Body Blast is an interval type training class that focuses on conditioning the cardiovascular system while increasing muscle strength. Exercises are moderate to high intensity, with active rest and water breaks.
Silver Sneaker Yoga	A modified yoga class with both seated and standing poses. Restorative breathing exercise and final relaxation will promote stress reduction and mental clarity.
Zumba Gold	Zumba Gold is a modified Zumba class for active older adults.
ESMMWL	a 15-week weight management program with your own registered dietician. Must be in the Ageless and Awesome Program.
TJQMBB	A 60-minute Yang-style Tai Chi that progresses from easy to challenging. Improves balance, coordination, and reduces falls by at least 58% upon completion.
Matter of Balance	This is a two-hour class that primarily focuses on reducing fears around falling, by developing cognitive skills to increase safety in and out of the home, and increasing activity levels. Snacks will be provided.
