## ROOKERY LIGHT COURT + BURNHAM LIBRARY GUIDED TOUR AND THE MARQ RESTAURANT

WEDNESDAY, MARCH 5, 2025

Join us for a truly inspiring architectural tour at the Rookery Light court and Burnham Library in the heart of Chicago's financial district. This tour shows testimony to the resilience and creative spirit of late-nineteenth-century Chicago. The rebirth of the city in the wake of the Great Fire of 1871, was one of the most luxurious commissions in Frank Lloyd Wright's career. Wright's successful renovation transformed the Rookery into a gleaming white and gold center of commerce. Following that, we will then visit the Burnham Library, where architects met to discuss the preliminary building plans for the 1893 World's Columbian Exposition. Before our tour, we will have a 3-course lunch at the Marq Restaurant.

## Class Details

<b>Circuit Training</b>	This is a supervised training class that involves timed rotations around each piece of exercise equipment. This class will occur in the fitness center, with a limit of 10 persons per class. You must sign up prior to participating. Sign up sheets will be posted on the fitness center door.
<b>Total Body Blast</b>	Total Body Blast is an interval type training class that focuses on conditioning the cardiovascular system while increasing muscle strength. Exercises are moderate to high intensity, with active rest and water breaks.
<b>Silver Sneaker Yoga</b>	A modified yoga class with both seated and standing poses. Restorative breathing exercise and final relaxation will promote stress reduction and mental clarity.
<b>Zumba Gold</b>	Zumba Gold is a modified Zumba class for active older adults.
<b>Chair Workout Warrior</b>	Chair Workout Warrior is an upper body focused training class. Emphasis on chest, back, arms, core and aerobics. Warm up can be done standing or sitting
<b>Mobility &amp; More</b>	This class focuses on self-care techniques such as increasing joint mobility, movability, range of motion, as well as trigger point therapy, lymphatic massage, breathwork and relaxation techniques. This class can be done seated or with the use of a mat.
<b>Fit &amp; Strong!</b>	A 90 minute exercise and health education program that helps manage arthritis decrease joint pain and stiffness, reduce anxiety and depression, improves daily functional movement and build strength.
<b>TJQMBB</b>	A 60-minute Yang-style Tai Chi that progresses from easy to challenging. Improves balance, coordination, and reduces falls by at least 58% upon completion.
<b>Matter of Balance</b>	This is a two-hour class that primarily focuses on reducing fears around falling, by developing cognitive skills to increase safety in and out of the home, and increasing activity levels.
