Anderson Japanese Gardens, Laurent House & Fresco Cafe, May 28, 2025



The *Frank Lloyd Wright Laurent House* tour offers a glimpse into his innovative designs, including how he adapted his architecture to cater to a client with physical disabilities, and how Japanese cultural elements influenced his work.

After the tour, transition into the serene atmosphere of the *Anderson Japanese Gardens* for lunch with overlooking the garden, followed by an afternoon stroll through nature. Experience this one-of-a-kind outdoor setting that inspires the mind and energizes the soul while highlighting the landscapes of streams, waterfalls, winding pathways, and koi-filled ponds has been rated one of North America's highest quality Japanese gardens. **The fee of \$130 covers transportation, guided tours, and three course lunch.** The trip departs at 8:30 a.m. and return after 3:30 p.m.

Lake Geneva Safari & Mars Cheese Castle Tuesday, June 3, 2025



Embark upon a memorable adventure with a visit to *Safari Lake Geneva*, where you'll experience the thrill of encountering exotic wildlife in a beautiful, natural setting.

Hop aboard an open-air vehicle and explore the park's expansive grounds, home to a variety of animals from around the world. After that, explore downtown *Lake Geneva* and have lunch on your own in the nearby restaurants. Jones Center and will return after 3:30 pm.

Class Details

Circuit Training	This is a supervised training class that involves timed rotations around each piece of exercise equipment. This class will occur in the fitness center, with a limit of 10 persons per class. You must sign up prior to participating. Sign up sheets will be posted on the fitness center door.
Total Body Blast	An interval type training class that focuses on conditioning the cardiovascular system while increasing muscle strength. Exercises are moderate to high intensity, with active rest and water breaks.
Silver Sneaker Yoga	A modified yoga class with both seated and standing poses. Restorative breathing exercise and final relaxation will promote stress reduction and mental clarity.
Zumba Gold	A modified Zumba class for active older adults.
Chair Workout Warrior	An upper body focused training class. Emphasis on chest, back, arms, core and aerobics. Warm up can be done standing or sitting
Mobility & More	This class focuses on self-care techniques such as increasing joint mobility, movability, range of motion, as well as trigger point therapy, lymphatic massage, breathwork and relaxation techniques. This class can be done seated or with the use of a mat.
Fit & Strong!	A 90 minute exercise and health education program that helps manage arthritis decrease joint pain and stiffness, reduce anxiety and depression, improves daily functional movement and build strength.
TJQMBB	A 60-minute Yang-style Tai Chi that progresses from easy to challenging. Improves balance, coordination, and reduces falls by at least 58% upon completion.
Matter of Balance	This is a two-hour class that primarily focuses on reducing fears around falling, by developing cognitive skills to increase safety in and out of the home, and increasing activity levels.
