The Senior Citizens Assessment Freeze Homestead Exemption applies to an owner occupied principal residence, for people 65 years old and older who meet the income limitations. Forms are automatically mailed to taxpayers who already have qualified for the Senior Homestead Exemption.

Dial A Ride

Disabled residents (16+) & Seniors (60+)

Over 15 million people under age 55 with disabilities have difficulty getting the transportation they need. Supervisor Jones has conducted meetings to develop a plan to address these transportation needs. The collaboration resulted in the expansion of the transportation program called Dial A Ride. This program will provide a vital lifeline for people who are Seniors (60+) and disabled residents (16+) to access employment, education, healthcare, and community life. The collaboration included; Waukegan Township, Shields Township, and Pace Paratransit.

RFCCC offers Mobile Health Screening and Services through the Community Care Connection, a vehicle that travels throughout Lake County, offering residents a variety of free immunizations and health screenings, including blood pressure, blood sugar, cholesterol, body mass index (BMI) and waist measurements, foot exams, osteoporosis screenings, and sports physicals for children and teens.

Often, when ongoing health concerns are identified, patients are connected to ongoing care at the free Inter-professional Community Clinic or a primary care provider or podiatric physician at the Health Clinics (which accepts Medicaid and Medicare).

Legislation Update:

HB 2762 Public Act 100-0306 prohibits a hospital from maintaining a list of individuals who may not be admitted for treatment at that hospital. This bill would not prohibit a hospital from recommending an alternate provider, coordinating an appropriate transfer, or arranging access to care services that best meet the needs of an individual patient. **Effective Date: Jan. 1, 2018**

HB 223 Public Act 100-0293 amends how identification wristlets may be used by nursing homes. A nursing home may now require a resident of an Alzheimer's disease unit with a history of wandering to wear a wristlet, unless the resident's guardian or power of attorney directs that the wristlet be removed. Currently, a wristlet can be employed only on a resident as ordered by a physician. The wristlet shall include, at a minimum, the resident's name and the name, telephone number, and address of the facility issuing the wristlet. The need for the resident to wear a wristlet shall be documented in the resident's clinical record. **Effective Date: Jan. 1, 2018**
