

Beginning this spring, Medicare will be sending out new cards to all beneficiaries. The new card removes the current Social Security-based identifying number and replace it with a random number/letter sequence that helps to reduce identity theft and fraud. The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) warns against scammers posing as Medicare "agents" or health care providers telling seniors they need to purchase a replacement card. The new Medicare cards are free, and everyone with Medicare will be mailed a card between April 2018—April 2019. The only action you need to take is to ensure Social Security has your current address, as the new cards will be sent to the address in their files. If you've been solicited by a scammer, report it by calling 1-800-447-8477.
