Warning AARP warning to seniors...Watch out for unwanted magazine subscriptions.

AARP just issued a new warning to seniors to watch out for another scam that's targeting them. The old magazine scam is alive and well, and the scammers have set their sights on seniors' life savings. Magazine companies are calling seniors and selling them magazines they don't want. And sometimes they even scam people who are calling to cancel subscriptions to magazines. In one instance, an unnamed senior called a magazine company to cancel two magazines. This person was moving to a new home and didn't want to receive the magazines anymore. But the magazine company representative instead scammed this senior. She talked very fast to this person just to cause confusion. Then she had the senior go through some steps with her bank card. At the end of the call, the senior asked if the magazines were canceled. Unfortunately for this person, the representative hadn't actually canceled the subscriptions. In fact, the representative simply said, "Oh, those are not our magazines." A few weeks later, the senior started receiving eight magazines! And the company charged a ridiculous amount for them. The senior was ripped off by the magazine company. This individual tried to stop the subscriptions by canceling their bank account, but then debt collectors got involved. For more information visit www.learnprogress.org/aarp-issues-warning-seniors.

OVER 64?? PLEASE READ!!

If you have reached age 65 and own your property and occupy the property, you are eligible for a savings of about **\$845** on your annual real estate tax bill. The **SENIOR HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION (SHE)** is administered through the Township Assessors' Offices. To apply, please visit the Waukegan Township Assessor's Office at 415 Washington Street Suite 206 (second floor) or call us at (847) 623-4550. You will need to bring a copy of the deed to the property (or the actual deed & we will copy it) when you apply.

You may also be eligible for the **SENIOR CITIZENS ASSESSMENT FREEZE HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION** (the "FREEZE") which has been in effect since 1994. Its requirements are the same as the (SHE), but also requires **annual household income of \$55,000 or less**. The application forms for year 2017, based on 2016 total household income are available at the Waukegan Township Assessor's Office.
