

SENIORS IN AIRLINE TRAVEL

The array of airport security regulations and the general discomfort that comes with airline travel can be especially trying for senior citizens. Below is a list of information you should know:

- 1) Senior citizens are able to request assistance in the airport.
- 2) The TSA has made several changes to its security policies to make the process easier for senior citizens.
- 3) Seniors traveling with medications will have no trouble transporting them through security as long as they bring a valid prescription for anything not sold over the counter.
- 4) Seniors and those travelers requiring special assistance can board before other travelers through priority boarding.
- 5) Though increasingly rare, discounted airfare is occasionally available to senior travelers.



Phony Phone Numbers

The Illinois Senior Medicare Patrol (SMP) and several SMPs in other states have received reports from people who have tried to call a legitimate government or social service agency only to end up talking to a potential scammer, who may ask for bank information or your Medicare card number. How does this scam work? Scammers use phone numbers similar to 1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227) to trick people misdialing that number. If you are calling Medicare or VA, they will not ask you for money or bank information. If this happens to you, report the call to the *FTC* at www.ftccomplaintassistant.gov or call the Illinois SMP at AgeOptions.

New Medicare Cards Are Coming - Scammers Are Coming Too

Your Medicare card number is a social security number, usually your own, and it is important to safeguard this number against identity theft and never give it to strangers over the phone.

Well, Medicare is changing the number. In April 2018, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) will start mailing out new cards to beneficiaries with an 11-digit combination of letters and numbers that has nothing to do with your social security number. By April 2019, all Medicare beneficiaries will have their new cards.

You will not need to do anything to receive your new card. It will be sent via mail.

Anytime there is a major change like this, scams will follow. Remember that Medicare will never call you to gather personal information and will never ask you to pay for this new card.

Any call that asks for this information is a scam and can be reported to the Illinois SMP at AgeOptions at (800)699-9043.

Inspector General Updates Public About OIG Impersonation Scheme

Gale Stallworth Stone, the Acting Inspector General of Social Security, is urging citizens to remain vigilant of a nationwide telephone impersonation scheme. Since alerting the public in early March about suspicious calls from people posing as Office of the Inspector General (OIG) investigators, the Social Security Administration (SSA) and the OIG have received additional reports and information about the phone scheme from citizens across the country. According to reports, the calls include a recorded message from an "officer with the Inspector General of Social Security." The recording states the person's Social Security account, Social Security number (SSN), and/or benefits are suspended, and the person should call a non-SSA number to resolve the issue. If a person receives a suspicious call from someone alleging to be from the OIG, citizens may report that information to the OIG at 1-800-269-0271. 
