Professionals will provide face-to-face assistance in completing the Senior Citizen's Assessment Freeze Homestead Exemption form as well as other exemption programs. The Senior Citizens Assessment Freeze Homestead Exemption applies to an owner occupied principal residence, for people 65 years old and older who meet the income limitations. Forms are automatically mailed to taxpayers who already have qualified for the Senior Homestead Exemption. The forms will be mailed to taxpayers in February with a due date of July 1, 2015.

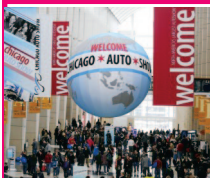

### Black Violin Genesee Theatre Friday, February 20th

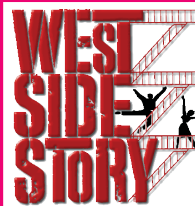
