National Trends in Homelessness

- ▶ Record high homeless counts
- ▶ 23% increase in first time homelessness
- ▶ Record high unsheltered homeless population
- ▶ 12.6% increase in Severe Housing Burden - those paying 50% or more of income towards rent
- ▶ Backward momentum with 7% increase in veterans 12% increase in those considered chronically homeless
- ▶ Response system is overwhelmed

Homelessness in Lake County

- ▶ Lake County Point in Time Count 2024
 - ▶ 50% increase in unsheltered homelessness
 - ▶ 53% of homeless people were in families
 - ▶ These are the highest numbers on record for Lake County
- ▶ 971 children aged Pre-K to 12 grade experienced homelessness according to the Illinois Board of Education in 2022



Staben House Serves

Single woman with children aged under 18

Mothers aged 18 years or older

Preference is given to local residents

2024 Applicant Data to date

65% have a history of domestic violence

68% describe their relationship with the children's father as “poor” or “none”

8% Receive child support

27% are employed





Waukegan Township is now a “Front Door” for homeless services and can assess people for addition to the “By Name List”




Staben House is working with Coordinate Entry to Receive appropriate referrals to Transitional Housing
